The major topics include the dynamics of the strategic triangle that defines cross-strait relations (Chapters 2 to 4) and the domestic politics and policies of Taiwan and China (Chapters 3 to 8) and the growing economic integration across the Taiwan Strait (Chapters 9 to 12). Overall, the future of this trilateral relationship appears to be fairly open-ended. Despite the current rapprochement, the ultimate goals of China and Taiwan remain incompatible. Cross-strait relations remain a viciously polarizing issue in Taiwan's domestic politics, and there is profound scholarly disagreement over the broader implications of the growing economic ties across the Strait.
