Train 1951 In close readings of these movies Padilla discusses myths and literary texts such as the Judgment of Paris The Homeric Hymn to Demeter Aristophanes s Frogs Apuleius s tale Cupid and Psyche Homer s Odyssey and The Homeric Hymn to Hermes Additionally many Olympian deities and heroes have archetypal resonances in the films in question Padilla also presents a new reading of Hitchcock s circumstances as he entered film work in 1920 and theorizes why and how the films may be viewed as an expression of the classical tradition and of classical reception This new and important contribution to the field of classical reception in the cinema will be of great value to classicists film scholars and general readers interested in these topics
